

For LK 150

Improved drop sleeve sweater  
size 44-46

Made with Red Heart # 4 yarn.

Front and Back Same.

Set Dial to 4.5 for ribbing,.

Cast on 124 stitches

Rib for 30 rows.

Change dial to 3.5

knit for 159 rows, (counter 189)

decrease 6 stitches each side for sleeve.

Knit 1 row

decrease 1 stitch each side every other row for 12 rows.

Mark center 41 stitches for collar.

Knit until row 297 bind off.

Sleeves make two.

Cast on 120 stitches

knit for 10 rows

decrease 1 stitch every 5<sup>th</sup> row until there are 42 stitches.

Rib for 20 rows.

Bind off. Mark center if sweater for shoulder.

Collar may be done seperate.

Cast on 82 stitches knit rows, rib for 20 rows.

This will give you a 2 inch collar.

If you want a fold over turtle neck, then just rib more rows.

Pin shoulders together, front and back, sew up, attach sleeves and collar.

Then sew up sweater.

Weave yarn ends in to edges to hide.

Then wear your sweater.
